Originally, CPB covered all aspects of the pharmaceutical sciences, however, since the topics covered by the above journal became increasingly diverse, as a new sister journal, BPB was created in 1993, also as a continuation of the Journal of Pharmacobio-Dynamics published since 1978. Now CPB covers physical and inorganic chemistry, organic chemistry, natural products chemistry, medicinal chemistry, analytical chemistry, pharmacognosy, and physical pharmacy. On the other hand, BPB covers analytical biochemistry, biochemistry, molecular and cell biology, microbiology, pharmacology, medicinal chemistry, pharmacognosy and biopharmacy, including all fields of life sciences such as genomics, proteomics, bioinformatics, structural biology, chemical biology and so on.
